City mowing was discussed. A motion by Wedemeyer and second by Lindberg for the mowing to be done by City public works, and will be reevaluated if needed. All ayes. Carried.

A motion by Lindberg and second by Sneller to have the change of City hall hours be effective immediately. All ayes. Carried.

Discuss was held regarding exploring the possibility of a new City attorney. A motion by Wedemeyer and second by Sneller to send out RFP to explore getting a new City Attorney. All ayes, Carried.

Discussion was held regarding the City mowing the ball field if it is going to be used for youth baseball this year. The Service club will be responsible for the water/sewer bill. Discussion of possibly reimbursing the service club for the amount of the water/sewer bills.
